## New Member Orientation

The Flying Electron's new member orientation has been designed to help new comers to the club and Radio Control aviation and to help have a better understanding of the procedures, etiquette and policies of the club.

### **What we expect**

The Flying Electrons are trying to maintain credibility as one of the finer clubs in the Greater Milwaukee Area. We expect members to abide by THE FIELD RULES and make safe flying their number 1 priority. Members should respect other members and their property. As a new member to the club and the hobby, we recommend that you have a 40 size high wing trainer type aircraft that has at least a four channel radio. All components are expected to be in good working order. You should possess all the necessary equipment to start and fly your own airplane. The club has Futaba/Hitec, Airtronics and JR trainer transmitters at the field for student use however, check to make sure your radio equipment is compatible. If not, you are expected to arrange to have a trainer transmitter compatible with you own equipment. All new members enter the club as students and must fly under the direction of a club-qualified instructor until attaining a solo pilot rating. If you are already an experienced flyer, the same rules apply. However, you may qualify for the solo pilot rating on your first flight.
